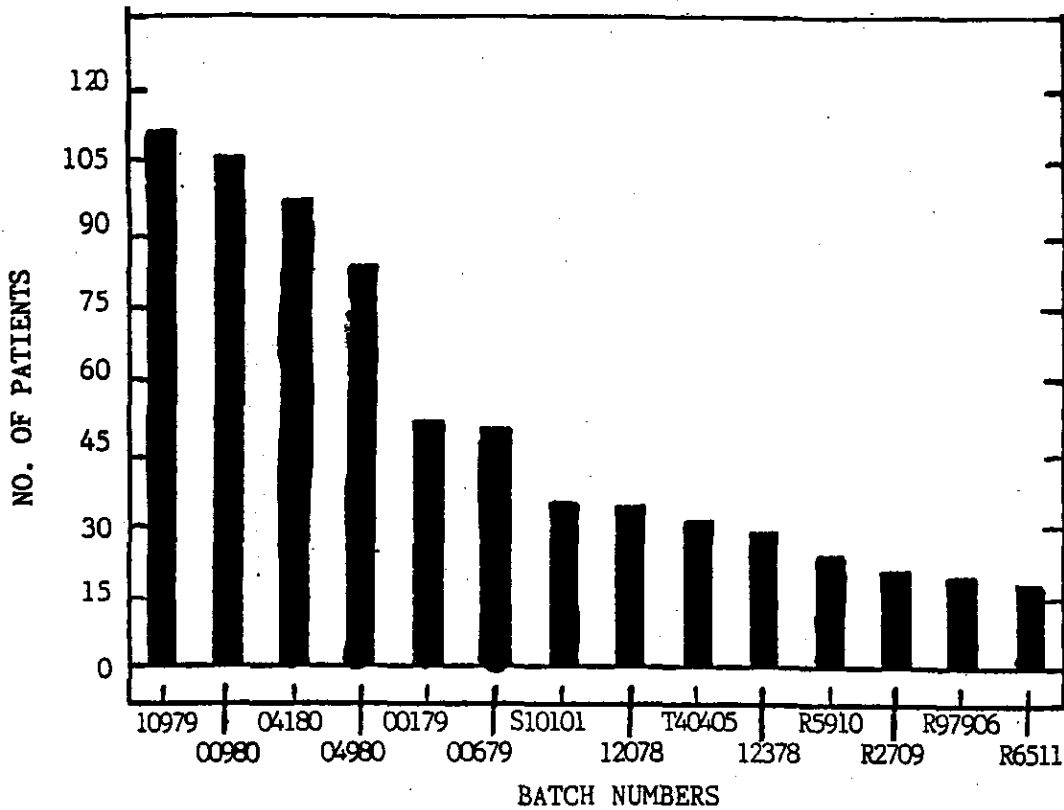

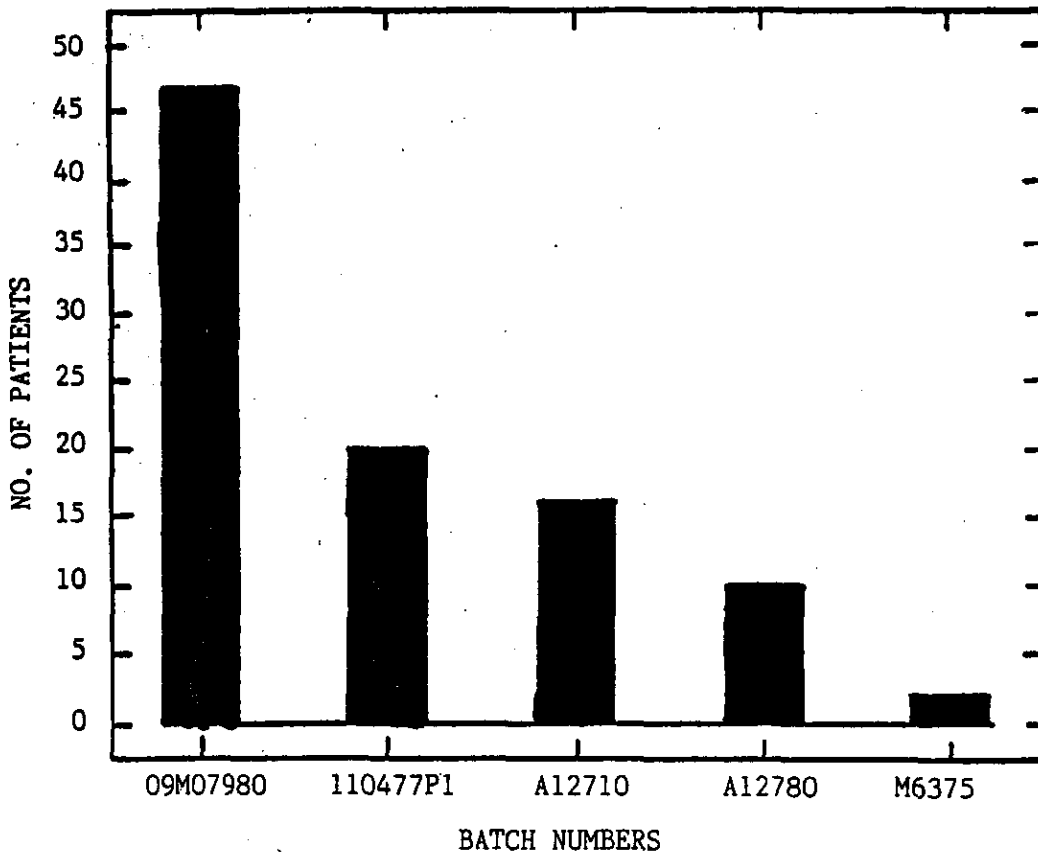


(I) - INDEX CASE

 FACTOR VIII RELATED TO AIDS CASE A/1

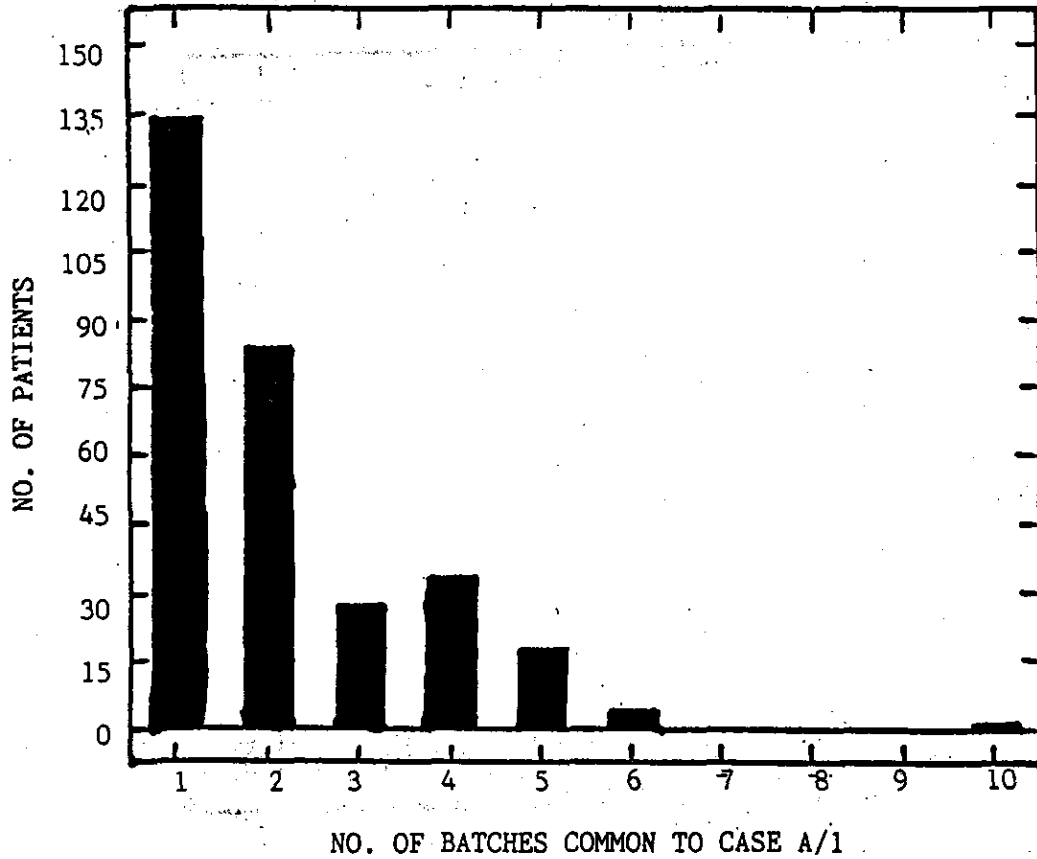


HISTOGRAM 2 - SHOWING NUMBER OF PATIENTS HAVING RECEIVED COMMERCIAL
 FACTOR VIII RELATED TO AIDS CASE A/4



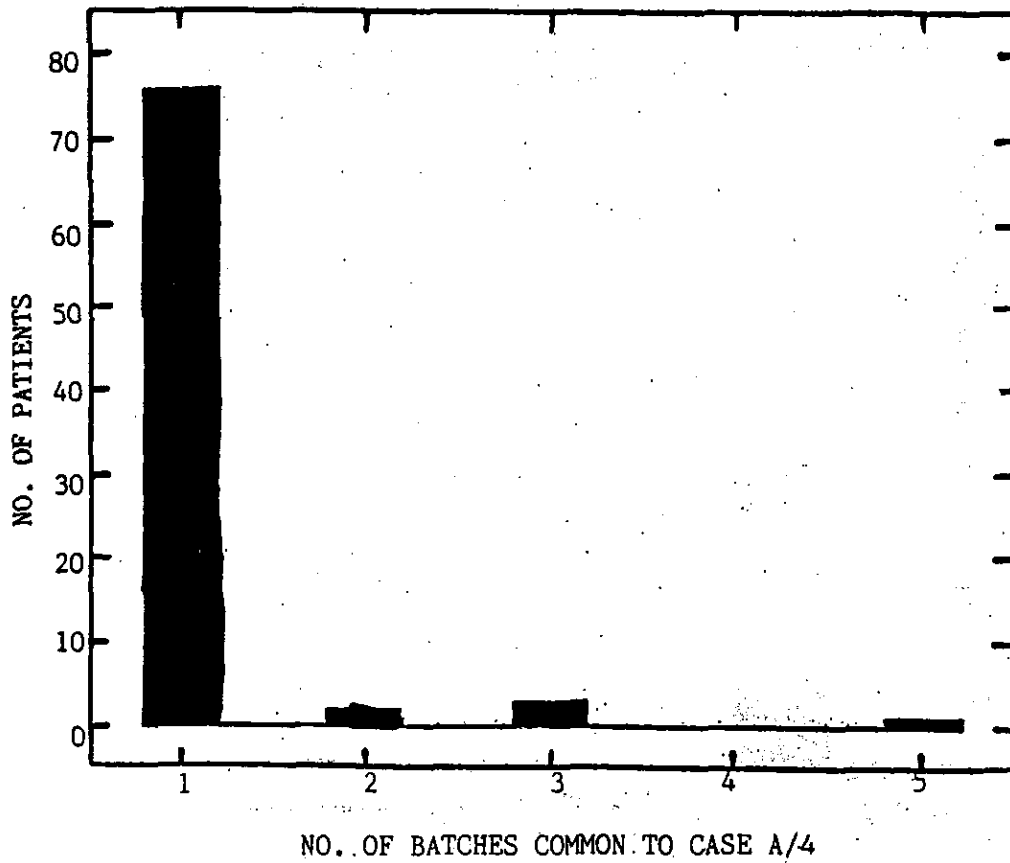
HISTOGRAM 3 - SHOWING NUMBER OF PATIENTS HAVING RECEIVED ONE OR MORE

BATCHES RELATED TO AIDS CASE A/1



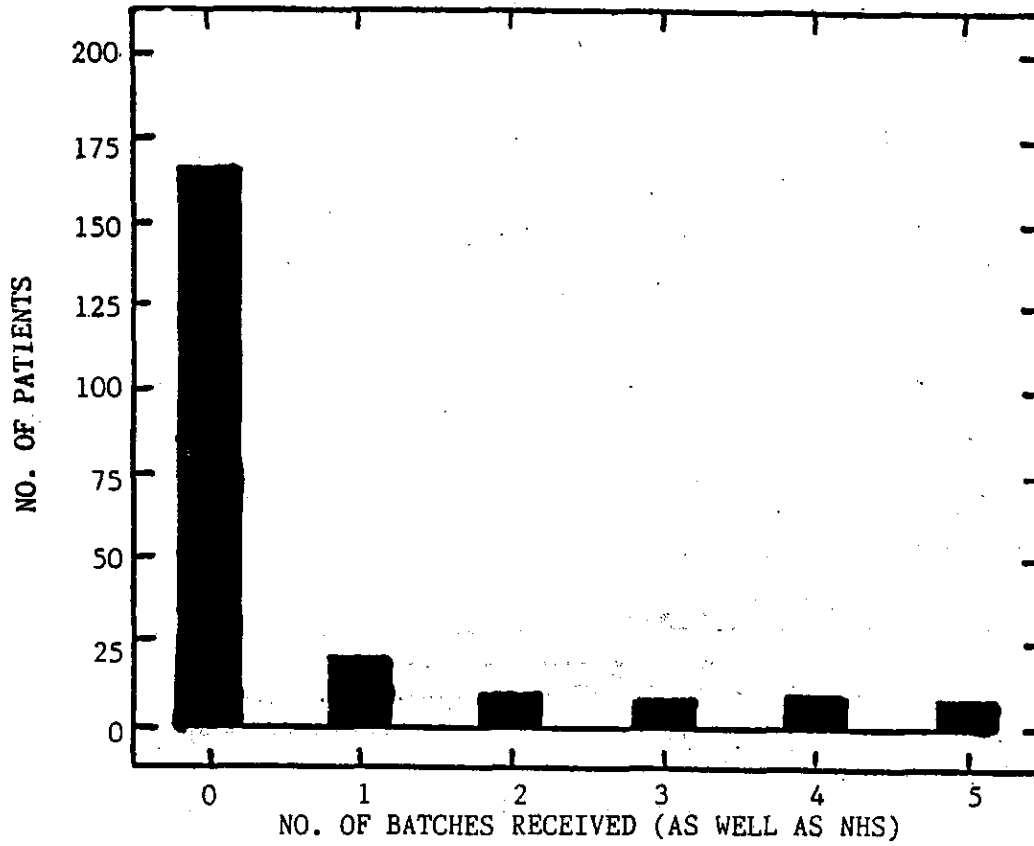
HISTOGRAM 4 - SHOWING NUMBER OF PATIENTS HAVING RECEIVED ONE OR MORE
